

THE MILL DRIFT TRACK

General Rules & Safety Requirements

Oregon – Private Property

Participation at The Mill Drift Track is voluntary and involves inherent risks. By entering the facility, all persons agree to comply with the following rules.

1. Facility Status

- The Mill Drift Track is private property
- No public access without authorization
- All motorsport activity is conducted off public roads
- Track management has final authority on all safety and operational decisions

2. Driver Eligibility

- Drivers must be 18 years or older
- Valid driver's license recommended
- Drivers must attend the mandatory driver meeting
- No reckless or unsanctioned driving

3. Waivers & Liability

- ALL drivers, passengers, crew, and spectators must sign a liability waiver
- Waiver includes:
 - Assumption of risk
 - Release of liability
 - Explicit release for NEGLIGENCE
- Minors:
 - Must have waiver signed by parent or legal guardian

4. Vehicle Safety Requirements

All vehicles are subject to inspection.

Minimum Requirements:

- Secure battery (properly mounted)
- Functional brakes
- Throttle returns freely
- No major fluid leaks
- Hood, trunk, and doors fully latched
- Seatbelts in good condition
- Muffler required
- Fire extinguisher securely mounted
- No coolant (Seasonally)

Strongly Recommended / May Be Required:

- Roll bar or roll cage REQUIRED for convertibles & fiber glass tops
- Tow hooks or visible tow points

5. Driver Safety Gear

- Helmet required at all times on track
 - DOT FULL FACE HELMETS REQUIRED
- Closed-toe shoes
- Convertibles: Roll protection

6. Track Operations & Conduct

- Drift ONLY in designated track areas

- No burnouts, drifting, or speeding in pits, parking areas & DEFINITELY NOT ON THE PUBLIC ROADS
- Follow all:
 - Flags
 - Hand signals
 - Staff instructions
- Zero tolerance for:
 - Alcohol or drug use
 - Aggressive behavior
 - Intentional contact

7. Spectator Rules

- Spectators must remain in designated areas only
- No crossing hot track or restricted zones
- Children must be supervised at all times
- Closed-toe shoes strongly recommended
- Track staff may remove spectators for unsafe behavior

8. Noise & Environmental Compliance

- Vehicles must comply with local noise limits
- Mufflers highly recommended
- No dumping of fluids
- Spill kits available on site
- All trash must be disposed of properly
- Respect surrounding properties and neighbors

9. Weather & Track Conditions

- Track sessions may be delayed or canceled due to:
 - Weather
 - Surface conditions
 - Safety concerns
- No refunds required for safety-related shutdowns

10. Insurance & Emergency Preparedness

- Event insurance maintained by organizers
- First aid equipment available on site
- Fire extinguishers positioned throughout facility
- Emergency access routes must remain clear

11. Right to Refuse or Remove

The Mill Drift Track reserves the right to:

- Refuse entry to any person or vehicle
- Remove drivers, crew, or spectators
- End any session without refund
- Modify rules at any time for safety

12. Acceptance of Rules

Entry into The Mill Drift Track constitutes acceptance of all rules, risks, and conditions of participation.
